

Members Exchange Federal Credit Union Policies and Procedures

Policy: Firearms Policy

Applies to: All Departments

Approved: October 29, 1996

The security of the Members, Board of Directors, Committee Members, Management, and Staff of Members Exchange Federal Credit Union is paramount. Safety is the Number one priority of this Credit Union.

Evidence compiled by Law Enforcement Agencies has shown that even though the Constitution of the United States of America grants the right to bear arms, many lives have been taken either by accident or by untrained persons. It has also been proven that many persons bearing arms do not have the judgment to make quick decisions in an emergency, and this has caused many situations to worsen by just showing a firearm. In many instances, persons have killed other employees or those who were hired for protection purposes simply because of misjudgment.

Due to the many hazards of carrying firearms/weapons, Members Exchange Credit Union will ban them in the credit union building and on credit union personnel, directors, and committee members.

Credit union-hired security and local law enforcement personnel are the exceptions to this policy.

I have read and understand that I will not be allowed to bring, store, or bear any firearms/weapons into this Credit Union building.
